ADMISSION POLICY

1. The age of admission is three years for Nursery and four years for L.K.G.
2. Admission to Christ Raja Convent School is made by a committee consisting of the Principal and two other sisters deputed by Local Community. The final decision will remain with the Principal who admits students to the School.
3. No third party is entertained in negotiations for admissions. Pressures are resisted firmly and politely.

Please Note:

1. The school does not charge capitation fees.
2. No donations are accepted.
3. Any attempt to use friends or influential people in procuring recommendation for admission will lead to disqualification.
4. Please do not request a meeting with the Principal or other school staff to clarify issues or any questions that you may have regarding Admission Process.
5. Preliminary information regarding Admission can be taken from reception.
6. New Admission to different classes is subject to the vacancies in each class, in the month of February after the Annual Results are declared.
7. No refund will be made of the amount deposited for admission.

Every new pupil must bring:

1. Date of birth Certificate (original & original copy) issued under RBD Act, 1969 according to the direction of the Registrar General of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India. Name once registered will not be altered.
2. Pupils applying for Admission, as a rule, subject to an entrance examination held at beginning of the academic year. They will be tested in the standard below the one to which they seek admission.

Students can be removed by the School authorities on any one of the following grounds.

1. Constant weakness in studies.
2. Irregularity in attendance.
3. Behavioral problems.
4. Moral breach considered serious by the School management.
5. Non-payment fee or chronic irregularity in payment of fee.
